- 2. Public Comment Period. No one appeared. No written comments were received.
- 3. Subdivisions. No subdivision plats were presented.
- 4. Audit: Audit of Fiscal Year Ended September 30, 2023. Audit of the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ended September 30, 2023. Still not completed.
- 5. District Engineer. Schiebe Engineering presented an amended fee schedule to its contract for engineering services. The motion was made and seconded that the amended fee schedule be approved. Following a discussion, the motion unanimously carried.

 - 6.1 Donation—Offer of Frank Russell to Donate to District the Drain and Canal Right-of-Way Shown Along East and South Sides of South 281 Subdivision [Cabinet 1, Pages/Slots 2118-B, 2119—A & B, Map Records]. Metes and bounds description of the land to be donated still has not been provided.
 - 6.2 Annexation-Request of Yountville Holdings, LLC, Owner, that District Annex 3,060.089 Acres Out of Share 22, Espiritu Santo Grant. Petition for Annexation still not submitted. No action.
 - 6.3 Donation-Drains in 3,060.089 Acres Out of Share 22, Espiritu Santo Grant, Owner: Yountville Holdings, LLC. Deed conveying drains to the District not presented. No action.
 - 6.4 Drain C-Right/Drain C-Left/Lateral V, Block 148, San Benito Land & Water Company Subdivision—Donation of Lateral North of Haine Drive. Agreement with Town and County Townhomes, Inc. still not finalized.

7. Equipment.

- 7.1 MowerMax Brushcutters. It was determined that the factory hydraulic pressure setting for both machines was incorrectly set too high. The damage to DD#39 has been repaired, and the machine is back in service. The damage to the hydraulic system of DD#38 was more extensive. The manufacturer took DD#38 to the factory for repair.
- 7.2 Backhoe–2024 John Deere Backhoe, Model No. 410 SL, purchased at May 10, 2024 meeting.
 - a. Tentative delivery is now August 2024.

- b. Clarification of sales price.
 - (i) The gross purchase price of the new backhoe with attachments was \$239,750.00
 - (ii) At the March 11, 2024 meeting, the Drainage District sold the 2012 D6K Dozer S/N CAT 00D6KEFBH01891 to Cameron County Irrigation District No. 2 for the \$50,000 trade-in value. The Dealer has accepted as a trade-in on the Drainage District's new backhoe two Irrigation District machines valued at a total of \$36,000.00, which reduces the amount owed by the Irrigation District for the Dozer to \$14,000.00.
 - (ii) The Dealer has taken the Drainage District's 2014 Terex Model TX840E SN: SMFJD4BCOCJKS1732, and 2017 Model 326 Caterpillar Long Reach Excavator S/N CAT 0326FKWGL10146, as a trade-in at a value of \$57,750.00.
 - (iii) After the credit for the two Irrigation District machines and the two Drainage District machines, the net sales price is \$139,000.00.
 - (iv) The Dealer declined to accept any of Units #DD7, DD#20, DD#21, and DD#24 as an additional trade-in.
- 7.3 Disposal of Equipment.
 - a. DD#22 New Holland 2014 Model TS6, SN NHO3023Mwith Maverick 30 has been sold by sealed bid. The bid / sale price was \$10,101.24.
 - b. DD#21 John Deere 2012 Model 6430, SN L06430BPCB732801 with boom mower has only scrap value.
 - c. Units DD#7, DD#20, DD#21, and DD#24 are still being offered for sale. To date, the District has received no bids for these machines.
- 8. Rancho Grande Diversion Project/Drain A Bypass Extension to River-Installation of Structure at Outfall. Engineer is still waiting on information.

 - 9.3 Drain B-2--Upgrade of Pennsylvania Boulevard Road Crossing. There was a general discussion about this project. The District's \$7 million Texas Water Development Board grant application is still pending.
 - 9.4 TWDB #40023 Flood Protection/Infrastructure Study–Hydrologic and Hydraulic Model Update. The grant application to include the City of San Benito has been approved.
- Drain E Between La Palma Street and Stenger Street. Notice of Drain Right-of-Way still not completed.
