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NOTICE OF MEETING BY TELEPHONE CALL

The Board of Directors of Cameron County Drainage District No. 3 will meet in Regular Session on Monday, August 10, 2020, at 2:00 p.m., to conduct the business of the District.

Due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 emergency, and pursuant to the Governor's disaster declaration, this meeting will be conducted by teleconference. No Board members will be present at the District Office. At least a quorum of the Board will be participating by telephone in accordance with the provisions of Section 551.125 of the Texas Government Code that have not been suspended by order of the Governor.

All individuals desiring to address the Board by telephone must be registered to do so, prior to the open comment period. Members of the public desiring to make a comment shall call the District at (956) 399-7637 between 1:00 p.m. and 1:50 p.m. on August 10, 2020, and register by providing his or her name. The registered speaker will access the meeting as stated above. When is time for comments to be heard, a moderator will move through the list of registered speakers, stating the name of each, at which time the speaker will make his or her comments.

The open public forum/comment period shall not exceed one-half (1/2) hour in length and each speaker will be allowed a maximum of three (3) minutes to speak. The purpose of this comment period is to provide the public an opportunity to address issues or topics that are under the jurisdiction of the District. For issues or topics which are not otherwise part of the posted agenda for the meeting, Board members may direct staff to investigate the issue or topic further. No action or discussion shall be taken on issues or topics which are not part of the posted agenda for the meeting. Members of the public may be recognized on posted agenda items deemed appropriate by the Board President as these items are considered, and the same time limitations (3 minutes) apply.


