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NOTICE OF MEETING BY TELEPHONE CALL

The Board of Directors of Cameron County Drainage District No. 3 will meet in Regular Session on Monday, June 8, 2020, at 2:00 p.m., to conduct the business of the District.

Due to health and safety concerns related to the COVID-19 emergency, and pursuant to the Governor's disaster declaration, this meeting will be conducted by teleconference. No Board members will be present at the District Office. At least a quorum of the Board will be participating by telephone in accordance with the provisions of Section 551.125 of the Texas Government Code that have not been suspended by order of the Governor.
